At first, you can imagine she was a bit skeptical that what Denise was explaining to her would all come to fruition. However, Roslyn knew that a car would be a blessing to one of our Family Promise families and she was familiar with the program.



Patrick has been working full-time at Dr.

Pepper and has had to rely on public transportation and family and friends to get to work. He has finally found a good job with benefits and a car would allow him to have reliable transportation and also make it possible for him to work overtime when offered. Sheri, his wife, is also looking for work. A car would aid her in her job search and also be helpful in taking their newborn infant to doctor visits and daycare.

Patrick and Sheri met with Dave, our caseworker, and filled out the necessary paperwork. It was explained that they would need to pay for the title, tags.



and insurance before they could receive the car, a Ford Escape. Firestone Complete Auto Care in Allentown committed to replace all the tires and give it a tune-up and oil change. Christ Lutheran Church, Allentown, offered to store the car on their parking lot until Patrick and Sheri saved enough to cover the amount, they were responsible for.

Patrick and Sheri were able to save the money they needed for the title, tags, and insurance in December - just in time for Christmas! They were so thankful and excited

to finally have a car.

Family Promise continues to work with this family as they continue to save and look for an apartment. We are always elated when we see the growth in our families and are grateful to be part of their journey. We invite all of you to join us as we work with families experiencing homelessness. I was attracted to Family Promise by the two core principles underlying its mission. First, we assist families, with children, as they transition themselves to stable housing and financial security. Second, the two important parties regarding homelessness are the homeless and those who want to help the homeless. It is our job to bring these two parties together. Our professional staff recruits, trains and coordinates the efforts of private citizens, using private facilities, thereby enabling them to assist their less fortunate neighbors in the best possible way. The work is daunting, there are about 1,900 children under 17, who are experiencing homelessness in Lehigh and Northampton counties.

In 2017, we were a small group of concerned citizens, meeting at fast-food restaurants and church social halls, planning the future. Today we have a director, two part-time staff members and over 500 volunteers representing 27 committed congregations. I have seen the hand of God assisting us every step of the way, sending us talented staff, volunteers, and generous donors.

My volunteer work and financial support are rewarded in multiple ways. I see the many families being helped; I see families coming back to contribute supplies to the program that assisted them escape homelessness; finally, I received a big hug from a young boy while delivering a mattress to our 6th Street apartment. He was finally going to have a bed of his own.

Volunteer Spotlight Saint Timothy Evangelical Lutheran Church

On Sunday, December 5th St. Timothy Evangelical Lutheran Church began its first week of hosting Family Promise families. Twenty-one members of the congregation and six volunteers from other churches donated their time to this event. Hosting weeks are aimed at supporting the families experiencing homelessness through food and lodging accommodations as they pursue the goal of getting an apartment and returning to a regular lifestyle.

These hosting weeks also have other unforeseen benefits to congregations. I can best categorize the benefits we received at St. Timothy's into three areas: (1) as the week progressed, the families and the volunteers began to see each other as friends with life's common concerns and issues; (2) the congregation, which met every Sunday, had an opportunity, while serving as dinner hosts, evening hosts, and overnight hosts, to get to know each other better and to see the benefits of their labors helping other people who were trying to complete a quality program that would give a new lease on life for them and their children; and, (3) the experience of serving the families gave our hosts an appreciation of the energy and commitment these families are making to keep their families together as a family unit under exceptionally difficult circumstances during very difficult times.

When we looked back on the hosting week, we all realized that this opportunity to host was a 'Gift of Purpose" that impacted our congregation as much as it impacted the families. Roslyn, thank you so much for giving us the opportunity to share in this heart-warming experience.
