# Welcome Board Officers

Fiscal year 22/23 began on July 1. That means it is time to thank our outgoing board officers. Thanks to Loretta Leeson, President; Dr. Larry Karper, Vice-President; Kathy Kling, Secretary and Keshia Macenat; Treasurer. We could not do what we do without you. We also want to welcome our new board officers.

President - Dr. Laurence Karper, MD is a psychiatrist in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania and is affiliated with Lehigh Valley Hospital-Muhlenberg and is the Vice-Chair for Acute Services of the Department of Psychiatry. He received his medical degree from Robert Wood Johnson Medical School and completed his psychiatry residency at Yale. He has been in practice for more than 25 years. His focus has been the treatment of chronic persistent mental illness and the prevention of chronic homelessness.

Vice-President - Alle Parker is a Campus Pastor and Executive Pastor at Life Church, which has seven locations spanning from Reading to Easton, including Church On Line. As a Campus Pastor, he and his wife have led the Life Church location in Macungie since its opening in 2015 and as an Executive Pastor, he oversees Campus Pastors. In addition to Family Promise, Alle also serves on the Boards for Child Evangelism Fellowship and Elevation Community Center. He and his wife Jessica have been married for twenty-one years and reside in Alburtis with their twin eighteen-year-olds, Emma & Noah, fourteen year old son Caleb and two dogs, Sam and Mocha.

Secretary - Mireille Meyerhoefer MD, PhD is a psychiatrist in the Lehigh Valley. 
